Dear

I remember being chosen to play for my school basketball team when I was about 14 years old. I was super excited. Our coach, a former professional, knew all there was to know about basketball. And he chose me for the team! There would be days when I would get up early and head to the school sports hall to train. I always made sure I was on time for team practice and did everything I could to learn from my coach. On match day I felt so special as spectators watched on during the games. It was quite something to be chosen for the team!



'You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you.' (John 15:16)

Within these pages you can read about this year's Big 3 mission. On the first night in Woolacombe our team was invited to share the Good News with a group of 20 or so teenagers at a local church. Team member Stuart shared testimony of how the Lord rescued Him, explained the Gospel, and invited the young people to make a decision to follow Jesus. There was an overwhelming response as many indicated such a decision!

It was amazing to see the Lord touching lives. It was a powerful moment. One of the youth leaders later shared; "Our youth strategy changed overnight... from reaching out to discipling!"

This switch to discipling is, of course, now crucial. There are plenty of people who make a decision for Christ and then sit back. Perhaps they attend church or some of the meetings, but they are not really living the call day by day. They are essentially spectators. Spiritually speaking, this is dangerous ground. As disciples we are chosen. The call of Jesus is "Follow me." (e.g. Matthew 4:19). Note - He calls us. He chooses us. We do not choose Him.

Being chosen for the basketball team was special. My perspective changed. My attitude changed. My commitment changed. How much more as a disciple of Jesus Christ when we see afresh that He chose us? We dare not be spectators. He has a purpose for our life, and the call is to give ourselves completely to Him and the cause of the Gospel.

TRAINING LEADERS FOR GOSPEL MINISTRY

Training leaders for Gospel-centred leadership is a key focus as we keep in mind the vision God has given K180... 'Europe Ablaze with the Gospel'. These last few months have seen some exciting initiatives including a very strategic gathering of our European 'Champions' in France...

HM European Champions Summit

In April, around 30 History Makers country leaders from 19 nations met in a beautiful place in northern France and spent an encouraging time together in prayer, worship, seeking the Lord and planning. They were encouraged in how to move forward in their countries with the History Makers 8 biblical core values, and to make more disciples of Jesus, all with the goal of reaching more nations with the life-transforming Gospel. HM Online French

Every month online History Makers training is given in French. This is open to any French-speaking nation. Therefore, aside from participants from Europe, we also have leaders from Africa and America who have now graduated from Module 1 and 2. We look forward to seeing further History Makers training set up across the French-speaking world.

HM Luxembourg

History Makers School in Luxembourg continues in partnership with a local church. Every 2-3 months, the participants meet on a Saturday to grow in their leadership as we explore some of the 8 core values that are at the heart of the History Makers training. We have completed 3 of the 4 sessions, and in July we will celebrate the graduation of our first cycle. A new cycle will begin in October. May God continue to open opportunities in this small nation in partnership with local churches.

TRAINING EVANGELISTS

Several of the EYE Network teams across Europe held training this Spring. It was heart-warming to see young evangelists gathering face-to-face in Germany, Spain and the UK, and online for French-speaking training. We are convinced that the raising of young evangelists is a key strategy for Gospel impact in Europe.





Philippus Netzwerk (Germany)

The training in Germany is at an exciting juncture. A new leadership team has formed with some exciting plans for the future as we seek to be faithful in providing sharp training across Germany. We are deeply thankful to Elmar Diener and Artur Penner who led the team with wisdom and tenacity over recent years, and grateful they remain close by! The training in March was a good springboard going forward and even looks to have launched a new team... in Georgia!

EEI (UK)

With guest speaker Mitch, from Crown Jesus Ministries, bringing some excellent teaching, this most recent module saw us tackle the subject of 'The Evangelist and Communication'. With some new participants joining, we took time to look at forming and delivering an evangelistic talk, which included each participant preaching for 5 minutes, and then braced to receive friendly critique! The goal is to sharpen each other as we pursue this precious call to proclaim Jesus. It was an encouraging weekend!







Red Timoteo (Spain)

Meeting just south of Madrid, young evangelists gathered to explore 'The Call of the Evangelist'. During the weekend, through teaching, group times, devotionals and simply time to connect and share experiences, we sought to encourage these evangelists who are early in their ministry call. We were particularly grateful for co-founder Hélder Favarin who brought some excellent teaching and now steps aside from the Red Timoteo team. Hélder is moving to the US to take up a new ministry position and will be very much missed in Spain. Please pray for Hélder and his family as they make this transition.



RJEF (French-speaking world)

A second online cycle of RJEF began in March. With a changed format, new participants gathered one evening on 3 consecutive weeks as they began this journey. In many ways RJEF is an 'experiment' arising from the pandemic. With many French participants from several countries joining our French-speaking initiatives during Covid, we decided to try this EYE Network group online to enable as many as possible to attend from across French-speaking Europe—and even from beyond! Module 2 is scheduled for October.

IT IS WELL WITH MY SOUL K180'S NEW EVANGELISTIC MUSICAL!

The premiere tour of "It is Well with My Soul" — our new, original and evangelistic musical written by Gareth Hides — has just finished after touring 4 venues in 4 nights! This summer, we are planning to host two further teams: a first-time visit from Mount Bethel UMC in Georgia (11-19 July) and a team from 'The Road' missions programme at Faithbridge Church in Spring, Texas (24 July – 5 August). THE JOURNEY

Further to partnering with Brentford Free Church (2021) and Clapham Baptist Church (2022), this year K180 has the joy and privilege of partnering with Cornerstone Church in the far reaches of West London.

It has been an encouraging start to the year, particularly seeing a weekly street ministry team form and plenty of 'God conversations' in the local community week by week. And it has been great to hear of new people coming along on a Sunday! Whilst they are not necessarily as a direct result of the street ministry, it is interesting to note that the Lord always seems to send new people to outward looking churches.

What is The Journey?

Many churches readily admit that they struggle to develop an "evangelistic culture" within the life of the church, although they yearn to see this happen. Often the demands of church life, the



pressure on time, and all manner of distractions, mean that taking time to develop an evangelistic thread through all that we are and do is neglected. In 2019, after an approach from the 'London Baptists', K180 developed a one-year church partnership initiative known as 'The Journey'.

What does The Journey entail?

Ideally, each of the following will be incorporated, but naturally we appreciate each context is different and we aim to 'tailor-make' our approach accordingly.

K180 will...

- Assign a trainee evangelist to work alongside the church for the equivalent of 2 days per week, helping to sharpen evangelistic focus
- Help bring focus to praying daily for unsaved friends and family, and aid everyday witness through appropriate tools
- Provide/lead two small group discipleship studies during the year; 'Christian to the Core' focused on discipleship, and 'The Unashamed Course' focused on day-to-day witness
- Help start a weekly street evangelism ministry
- Provide an advanced mentoring opportunity for a selected group, lasting 6
 months (meeting monthly) that will include book study, mandate to disciple
 another, one-to-one mentoring, participating in an evangelistic mission
 weekend, and planning an evangelistic event for the church
