The Gospel is changing lives across the world, even today, more than we perhaps realise. From time to time, God gives us a glimpse of what He is doing and it is like drinking a glass of cold, refreshing water on a hot day.

One such moment came as we were leading some street evangelism training in Ljubljana, Slovenia. At our first training session, a man called Goran made a beeline for me. I remembered him from some History Makers leaders training we had held in Ljubljana 5 years before. The first thing he said to me was;



"Martin, do you remember me? I want you to know that History Makers changed my life."

He went on to explain that he had not wanted to attend the History Makers training, but his line manager made it mandatory. And God spoke powerfully to Goran, giving a clear vision to plant a church where there was, at that time, no Gospel witness.

That History Makers weekend ultimately led to him resigning from his job and, with his wife and children, planting a church in Domžale, a town where there was no evangelical church. This church has now been there around 4 years and, whilst relatively small in number (around 20), it is steadily growing. Indeed, when I visited in September, there were at least two 'not-yet-believers' from the local community who had come for the first time.

In October, we hosted a 'Street Evangelism Taster Morning' in Ealing, which was well attended by several from other parts of London, plus some from the Ealing area. Gareth and Hayden led some helpful basic training, followed by going to the streets with the Gospel. For some in attendance, this was their first experience of street evangelism.



In November, we were invited by All Nations Revival Church in Mitcham to lead some evangelism training and go to the streets together. Please pray for Pastor Kevin and others at the church as they seek to establish a regular outreach on the streets, complementing the other ministry with which they are already involved.

 refreshing time and a catalyst for ministry for all who will attend.


ON MISSION IN SLOVENIA AND NORTH MACEDONIA

In September, we sent two teams to Ljubljana and Štip, to serve alongside local churches in Gospel ministry on the streets.

In Slovenia, we connected with brothers and sisters at Ljubljana Evangelical Church, leading some evangelism training which was attended by some from other churches, took time to prayer walk and intercede for the city, and preached the Gospel on the streets where many stopped to hear the Gospel, including a young man from Belgium who made a recommitment to follow Christ. We were also able to visit a church plant - led by Goran, an alumnus of History Makers - in Domžale, a nearby town.

In North Macedonia, we were again hosted by Oasis Church, led by Pastor Angel and his wife Daniela. The team was made up of people from South Hanwell Baptist Church, which was a great encouragement as this is my (Gareth's) home church. Evangelism training was well attended and we were able to share the Gospel on the streets of Štip, which saw many thousands visiting from other cities for a food festival. The opportunities were certainly plentiful, with several key Gospel conversations being had.

THE JOURNEY

We have just officially concluded our year-long partnership with Cornerstone Church in West Drayton, West London. It has been an adventure indeed and we have much gratitude to God! One of the stand-out highlights has been the formation of a street ministry team that is committed to taking the Gospel into the local town centre every Saturday morning. It is most encouraging to see young people committed to that team and to hear testimonies of clear Gospel conversations after every outreach. New people have started coming to the church, including through the street outreach and, of more importance, people are growing as disciples of Christ. To God be the glory!

What is The Journey?

Many churches readily admit that they struggle to develop an "evangelistic culture" within the life of the church, although they yearn to see this happen. Often the demands of church life, the pressure on time, and all manner of distractions, mean that taking time to develop an evangelistic thread through all that we are and do is neglected. In 2019, after an approach from the 'London Baptists', K180 developed a one-year church partnership initiative known as 'The Journey'.





What does The Journey entail?

Ideally, each of the following will be incorporated, but naturally we appreciate each context is different and we aim to 'tailor-make' our approach accordingly.

K180 will...

- Assign a trainee evangelist to work alongside the church for the equivalent of 2 days per week, helping to sharpen evangelistic focus
- Help bring focus to praying daily for unsaved friends and family, and aid everyday witness through appropriate tools
- Provide/lead two small group discipleship studies during the year;
 'Christian to the Core' focused on discipleship, and 'The Unashamed Course' focused on day-to-day witness
- Help start a weekly street evangelism ministry
- Provide an advanced mentoring opportunity for a selected group, lasting 6
 months (meeting monthly) that will include book study, mandate to disciple
 another, one-to-one mentoring, participating in an evangelistic mission
 weekend, and planning an evangelistic event for the church

Georgia

September saw History Makers training hosted with a focus on international churches. It was a blessed time with around 50 participants. Two Nigerian churches and one Indian church were represented, as well as North Caucasian participants, and a Ukrainian pastor from Poland who serves the refugees. Armenia

In October, History Makers took place once again in Armenia. Many leaders gathered to explore the 8 core values. During the week, participants walked through each of the values with opportunities to put into practice the aspects taught each day by means of small workshops and devotionals. TRAINING EVANGELISTS

Many of you reading this will know that we consider the identifying and equipping of young evangelists as a key strategy for Gospel impact in Europe. It has been an exciting few months of training, and also of planning...

Spain

Young evangelists gathered just outside of Madrid for the

next instalment of Red Timoteo (Timothy Network). Together we explored the theme: 'The Evangelist and Context' and sought to wrestle with the question of how we bring the relevancy of the Gospel into the present Spanish cultural context. It was encouraging to see this army of young evangelists eager to be equipped and sent back onto the mission field!

It was a privilege to welcome a number of new participants for this latest module, which focused on 'The Evangelist and the Church'. This particular module is often very challenging to the participants as we explore what it means to be rooted in the local church and how we mobilise the Body of Christ in evangelism. Further to some excellent input from Peter Kennelly (Open Air Campaigners) and Glenn Johnston (from Northern Ireland) we know that these young evangelists were stirred...

Germany

The Philippus Netzwerk (Philip Network) leadership team has recently experienced some changes, and we are delighted that Peter Wiebe (To All Nations) and David Byle (OM) have joined the team as we seek to encourage and equip young evangelists in Germany. We met in the beautiful village of Elend in early December with several new participants joining, and there is a tangible sense of expectation as we head into 2024 with the training opportunities ahead of us.



Practical Application for EYE Network evangelists in training

Alongside the residential training weekends, we seek to regularly provide practical opportunities for EYE Network participants. We strongly believe that such opportunities give rich experience and are a catalyst for Gospel growth and, therefore, Gospel impact. We aim to provide evangelistic mission experiences in different cultural settings where EYE Network participants can exercise gifting, as well as be inspired, as they engage in proclaiming the Gospel alongside each other and local churches.

As such, in October, a team of 12 young German evangelists travelled to the city of Essen to work alongside local churches in proclaiming the Gospel in their community. Additionally, and as a key aspect of this practical opportunity, the team experienced getting 'behind the scenes' of the major evangelistic initiative being conducted by the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association at that time. It truly was an inspiring time as we laboured alongside local believers and then worked with the BGEA team as over 6,900 people gathered to hear the Gospel proclaimed by Franklin Graham. We thank God for the many who came to Christ that weekend.

TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

As we said "Farewell" (for now) to Hayden in December (see page 7), it seems a good time to highlight the ongoing opportunities available for K180 trainees. Training others, particularly young evangelists, has been at the heart of K180's DNA right from the beginning. We tailor-make traineeships based on an individual's availability and budget, usually anything from one week to one year! (On rare occasions sometimes longer). Our traineeships are for those aged 18-35 who are exploring the call to Evangelist or who already have a sense of call as an Evangelist and who are seeking to be equipped to proclaim the Gospel.

Traineeships typically include:

- Short-term European weekend missions (availability depends on schedule/time of year)
- Regular creative street ministry in London
- Evangelism training
- Exploring evangelistic ministry in a local church context with one of our partners (usually a formal placement if traineeship is 6 months or longer)
- Developing evangelistic literature (writing Gospel tracts/flyers)

UNASHAMED COURSE

The 'Unashamed' eight-week course was birthed with a clear intention: to equip for day-to-day witness by answering the "But how?" of evangelism. Firmly rooted in Scripture, and with plenty of practical advice and a challenge at the end of each session, this training sharpens us as ambassadors.

From September to November, the Unashamed Course was held in eight weekly online sessions in French. A small group of participants, including those from Belgium and France, were challenged week after week. And what a thrill to hear some of the testimonies from participants who took up the challenges and, with the Lord's help, put them into practice.

He gave some practical ways we could grow in this, recommending we ask Jesus to teach us to pray and to keep us in prayer for souls.
